## Project Name: Drinking water & Dry Ration support to the affected families

---

As you know, cyclone Amphan has ripped through several South Bengal districts damaging hundreds of crores worth of property, crops, and livestock. The worst to be affected were the South 24 Parganas and the coastal areas of the North 24 Parganas. Among South 24 Parganas, Sagar, Namkhana, Kultali, Jaynagar-I, Jayanagr -II and Patharpratima blocks have been most affected. In these areas, vast stretches of river embankments, bridges and lamp posts have been damaged. Innumerable trees have fallen, and thousands of houses flattened. River water has gushed in and swayed away cattle's and livestock. Kuccha houses have been flattened. Clumps of mud and strewn frugal belongings are the only remnants of houses that once stood there. Rooftops have either broken or flown away by the severe storm, leaving the families without any shelter. The cyclone has damaged hectares of agricultural land, forests and the rich mangrove population and has severely damaged schools, warehouses, and piped water schemes. Official reports estimate that life of 4.5 million people got affected alone.

### Scope of activities

---

MUKTI is attempting to reach out to maximum impacted families to provide them with the immediate requirements of drinking water. Post Amphan, the villagers were forced to drink the salty water. MUKTI step in with your generous help and we reached out to 6 such villages for continuous 15 days at **Mathurapur-II block** who were badly in need of drinking water and with your support we could able to help them tide over the crisis on an immediate basis. With your valuable support, we successfully managed to provide: -

- Drinking Water support to the affected villages.
- Dry Ration support to the needy people.

An Extended time rehabilitation would be needed to recoup from the ravages of the Amphan. Right now, we have only managed to provide immediate relief to near about 25,000 impacted families. The economy and lives of these people need to be rebuilt and revived. We would like to help rebuilding homes and economy by helping in nursery preparation and paddy seedling distribution, setting up more medical camps across the area, providing food security for the migrant labours, repairing schools and giving out micro-loans to repair houses and initiate livelihood generation. We have prepared an Amphan Relief Recovery Plan and progress we made till date We look forward to your continued support in any of the below mentioned areas. **If there is any other aspect that you would like us to implement, we would be more than happy to discuss the same with you.**
