#### **Clock Tower**

This iconic structure is the most well-known of all and has always found its place in the logo of the institute. The Turret Clock of the Clock Tower was installed in the year 1921 and was donated by Sir Rajendranath Mukherjee, an alumnus of the 1883 batch, and chief engineer of Howrah Bridge and Victoria Memorial.



#### Odyssey

This is a Gallery of Historical Events. The journey of our institute from 1856 to the present day is carved in thirteen stone tablets. The 200 kg giant bell in the center is over a century old. In 1820, it was installed in a tower beside the then Bishop's College. It is said that the renowned poet Michael Madhusudan Dutta - who stayed in Bishop's College during that time - used to wake up in the morning hearing the sound of this bell.


