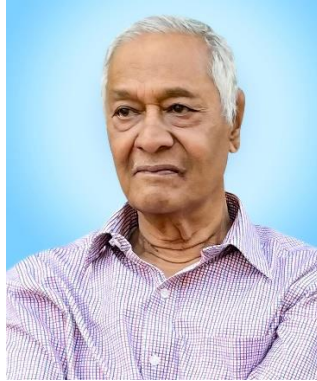


In Memoriam

Abhijit Niyogi graduated with a BE in Civil Engineering from Bengal Engineering College, Shibpur, in 1965. He then completed his postgraduate studies in Civil Structural Engineering. In 1967, he joined the Defense Ministry through the Indian Engineering Service Examination (IES) conducted by UPSC.

He served the Defense Ministry as a design and construction engineer for various projects, including airports and allied structures for the Indian Air Force, docks and allied structures for the Indian Navy, and strategic structures and army roads for the Indian Army across different states such as Jammu & Kashmir, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, and West Bengal. He held several positions, including Assistant Executive Engineer, Executive Engineer, Superintending Engineer, Chief Engineer, and retired in April 2004 as Additional Director General D&C CME.

He also published numerous technical papers in various significant journals, including the Indian Road Congress (IRC).
